At this time, all classes are cancelled in line with both the BCSD (which includes the Community Campus studio) and YMCA from March 16 - April 4.

We will continue to evaluate whether we can proceed with our May 8-9-10 performance, but this is dependent on the recommendations of the CDC, SC Health District and BCSD. We are also concerned about the capacity issues of the theater. There are options to postpone the shows and/or ultimately reschedule. If we can proceed after April 6 our faculty is committed to making the show happen....I know everyone is disappointed about the possibility of not performing, but we need to remain safe as we navigate thru changes in our social structure and health well being.

In the meantime - get outside, plenty of rest, lots of fluids and find moments to breath and remember we are all working on this together.
