Adrienne Kerr - Principal dancer with Ballet Idaho. She received bronze honors at YAGP in Denver and Dallas and performed in the NYC national finals. At age 14, she accepted a full scholarship to train at PNB in Seattle, WA. and at 17 signed her first professional contract. Her roles have included Nutcracker, Beauty & the Beast, Giselle, Sleeping Beauty, Don Quixote, Swan Lake, Firebird, Midsummer Night's Dream, Cinderella and numerous Balanchine, neo-classical and contemporary works. Adrienne has also performed for Project Flux, Boise Dance Co-op, and is a requested teacher & coach in ballet, pointe, variations and jazz. She will teach ballet, pointe and variations.

Lydia Sakolsky-Basquill - born in NY, Lydia moved to Boise at a young age to start her dance training. She started her college training at New World School of the Arts, focusing on Graham, Limon and Horton techniques, earning her BFA from Arizona State University. She has worked all over the US but launched Project Flux Dance in Boise and is happy to be creating dance all over the Boise area. Lydia has created over 30 professional works and collaborated with numerous organizations throughtout the globe. Her choreography has received numerous awards. She will teach modern and choreography.

Austin Fernando - a San Diego native, has trained, performed, competed, and directed in the S. California area for most of his life before moving to Idaho. He became serious about Hip Hop dance in HS training at studios such as Culture Shock and Studio FX. While attending Univ of Cal. Irvine, he danced with Common Ground competing and choreographing and showcased at BoogieZone United in Japan. In San Diego he danced with SGBM competing at events like Vibe and BodyRock. He currently directs AF Dance in the Treasure Valley, competing at events like World of Dance, BodyRock Jrs., Prelude & Hip Hop International. He will teach hip hop and choreography.

Mariel McEwan - part dance historian, costume designer and filmmaker, Mariel received her Masters in Dance History from U. of NM. She worked in NY with the Baroque Dance Company for over 15 years. Completed her film degree at the American Film Institute. She collaborated with FDC on a dance-camera piece "Pilgrimage" at the Sawtooth Botanical Garden and won Gold at the Indonesian Film Festival in Jakarta. She also worked on the ballet "Night of the Paris Opera" with Footlight experimenting with animated slides over a background of French Impressionistic art. She now lives in Madison, WI. and is excited to be back in Idaho to teach Baroque dance & mask making.
